The Alliance Française has decided to introduce **new courses** targeting specific skills. After the first year of French, students can choose to attend tutoring classes and/or classes to develop their speaking & listening skills. These courses will help the students to strengthen their weaknesses and prepare for exams with more confidence.

Each year, three DELF-DALF sessions are organized; in May, September and November. During the month prior to each DELF session, a specific preparation course will be organized in order to better prepare the candidates for the examination.

The DELF is a diploma granted by the French Ministry of National Education in recognition of French-language studies. This diploma is recognized around the world, and it is valid for the rest of your life!

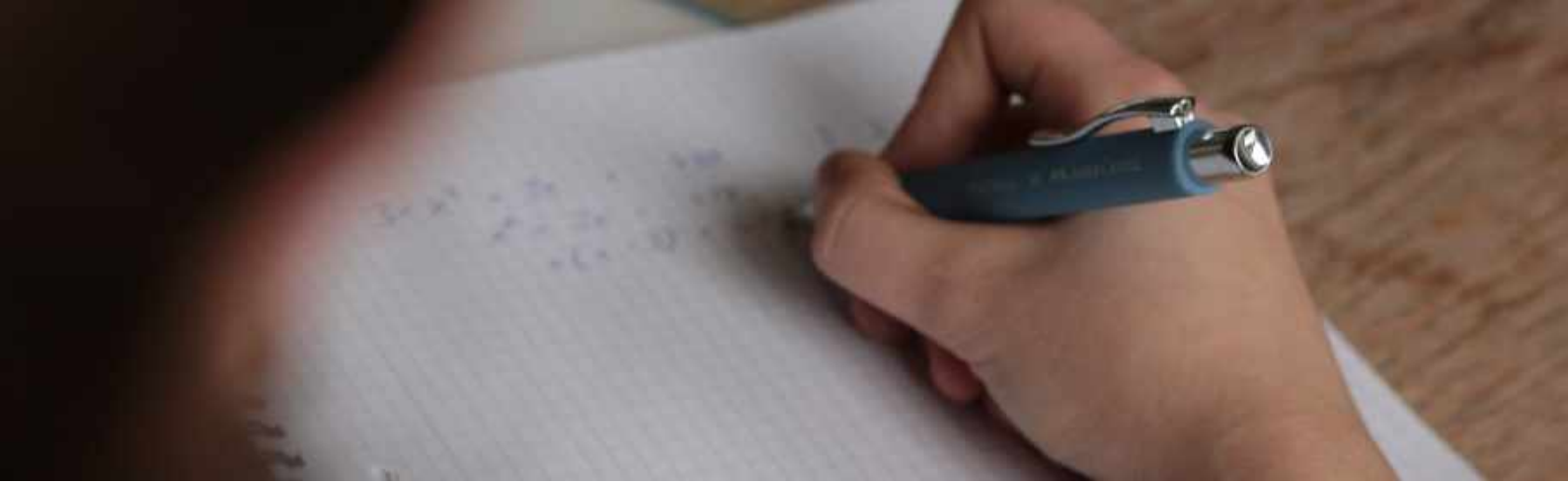

Whether your motives are personal, vocational or part of a structured training plan, the Alliance Française will help you find the appropriate learning programme. We will accompany you along your path to achieve a French language fluency.

Courses follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and offer a preparation for the DELF/DALF certifications. A CEFRL sublevel table is included at the end of the brochure for self-evaluation. Placement tests can be organized for learners unsure of the class matching their level. The placement test fees (€25) are reimbursed upon registration to one of our courses.

The DELF-DALF are diplomas granted by the French Ministry of National Education in recognition of French-language studies of foreign candidates. They are internationally recognized and remain valid for life. Each year, three DELF-DALF sessions are organized; in June, September and December. During the month prior to each DELF session, a specific preparation course will be organized in order to better prepare the candidates for the examination.

For those wishing to attain their language goals faster, the Alliance Française offers various Intensive courses. On the contrary, for those who are not interested in examinations and only wish to stay in touch with the French language and culture, you can choose amongst the various conversation classes offered.

BASIC USER	A1.1	<p>Can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type.</p> <p>Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has.</p> <p>Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.</p>
	A1.2	<p>Can understand some familiar and daily expressions used in very recurring situations of communication as well as very simple statements aiming at satisfying certain concrete needs of the social life and can produce some.</p> <p>Can identify himself and answer questions concerning, for example, his nationality, his age, his place of residence, his school and possibly, to ask himself questions of this type to somebody.</p> <p>Can participate in an ordinary interaction, at least partially, by means of simple statements (centered on one or two words) also by using his mother tongue or other acquired language tongues if the interlocutor speaks slowly and clearly and shows himself cooperative and friendly.</p>
	A2.1	<p>Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment).</p> <p>Can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.</p> <p>Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.</p>
	A2.2	<p>Can initiate, maintain and close simple, restricted face-to-face conversation; understand enough to manage simple, routine exchanges without undue effort.</p> <p>Can deal with everyday situations with predictable content, though he/she will generally have to compromise the message and search for words.</p> <p>Can give an extended description of everyday aspects of his/her environment e.g. people, places, a job or study experience; describe past activities and personal experiences; describe habits and routines; describe plans and arrangements; explain what he/she likes or dislikes about something.</p>
INTERMEDIATE USER	B1.1	<p>Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.</p> <p>Can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken.</p> <p>Can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest.</p> <p>Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.</p>
	B1.2	<p>Can take messages communicating enquiries, explaining problems; provide concrete information required in an interview/consultation (e.g. describe symptoms to a doctor) but does so with limited precision.</p> <p>Can explain why something is a problem; summarise and give his or her opinion about a short story, article, talk, discussion, interview, or documentary and answer further questions of detail.</p> <p>Can carry out a prepared interview, checking and confirming information, though he/she may occasionally have to ask for repetition if the other person's response is rapid or extended.</p>



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
